You may have noticed some activity recently in the area around the historic Red Rover Mine site. In fact, in the next few weeks you'll likely see a survey drone flying over the property, gathering specific information about the topography and terrain. The owners of this property are seeking County approval to use state-of-the-art technology to process and reclaim surplus rock from private property north of the Mine. These materials, which today make up the two small hills located at the end of West Avenue V, were originally created by the operation of the Mine in the late 1800's and early 1900's. The property's longtime owner, Red Rover Mine, Inc., and their joint venture operating partner, Black Rock Development are committed to performing all activities in accordance with every regulatory requirement. We look forward to sharing more information about this project and to answering any questions you may have.
